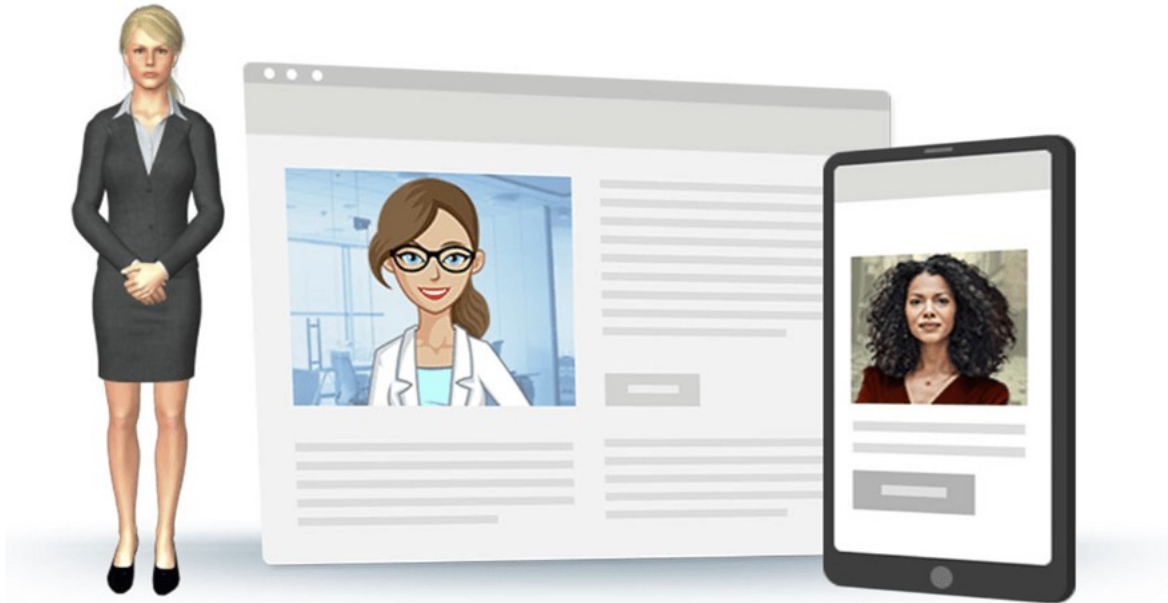


# Embedding SitePal into Different Platforms



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## About this document

Typically embedding your SitePal Scene into your web page is a simple matter of copy paste. Copy your SitePal embed code from your SitePal "Publish" area, and paste it into the html document which is your web page.

But some popular web hosting platforms or web page creation tools may require an extra step or two - as the procedure may not be obvious. That's where this document comes in.

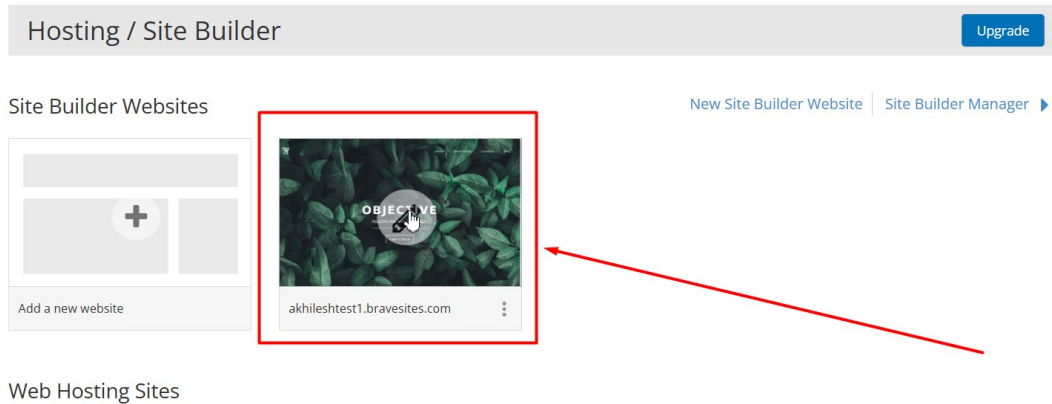

Also, if the tool/program that you are using is not on this list and you believe it should be - please let us know.

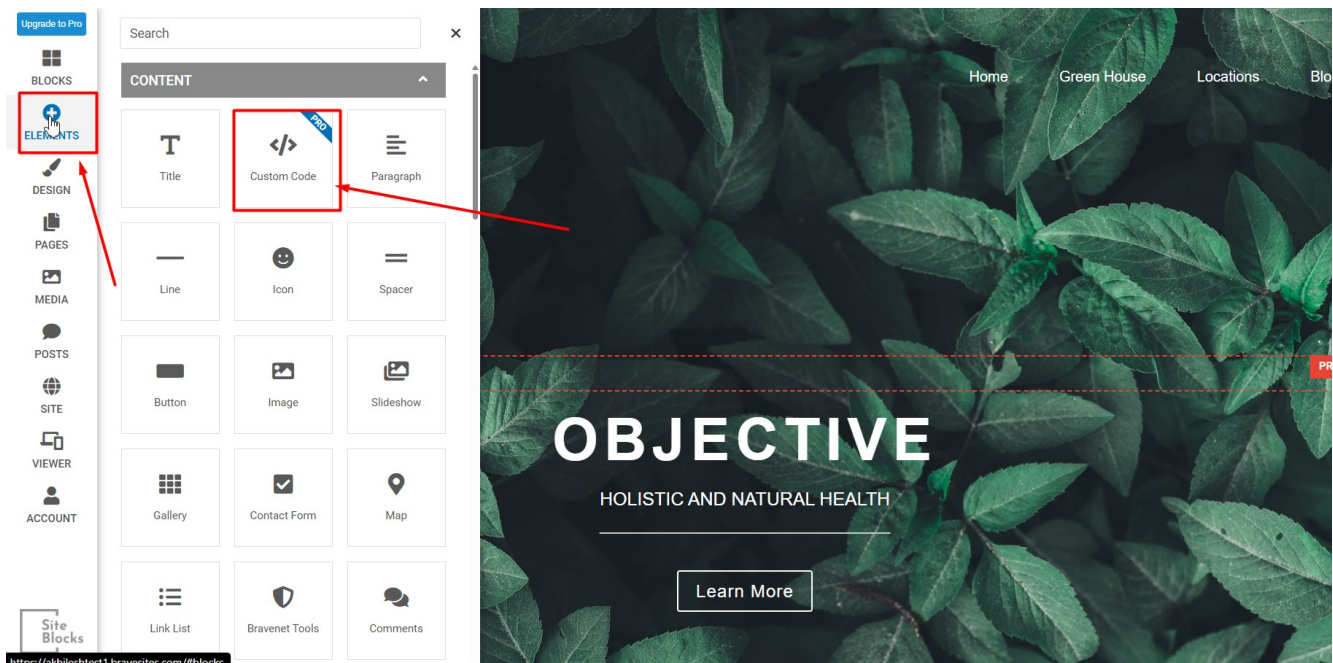

## A – Bravenet

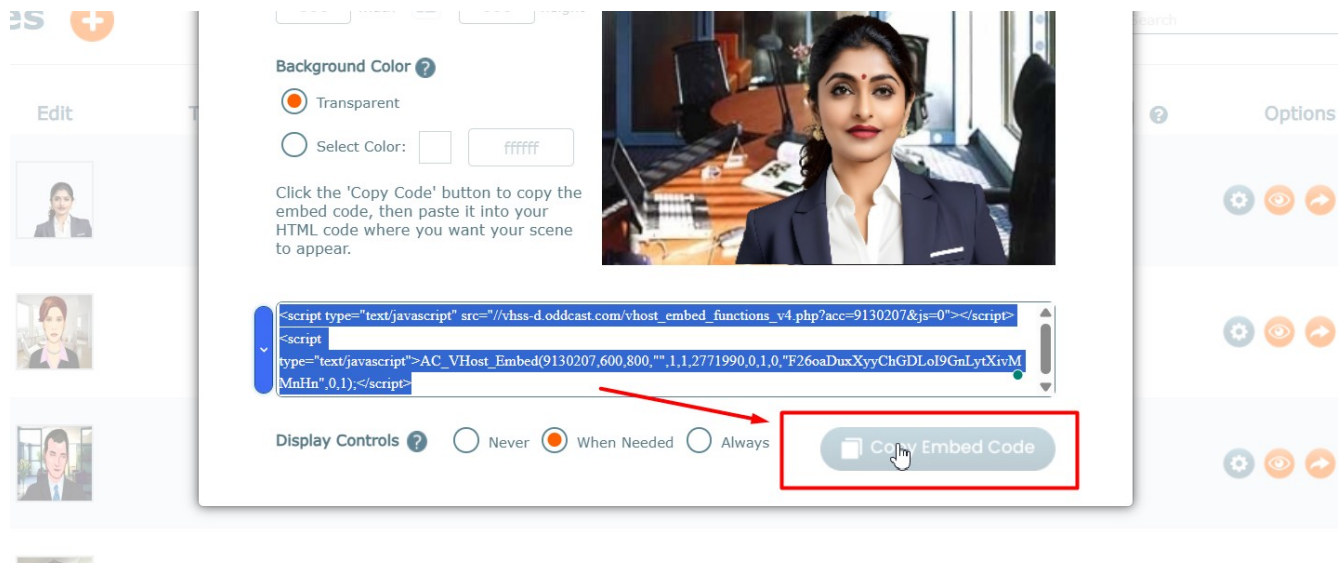
Step 1: Go to the Site Builder in which you want to update your Sitepal avatar and open the page in website editor.



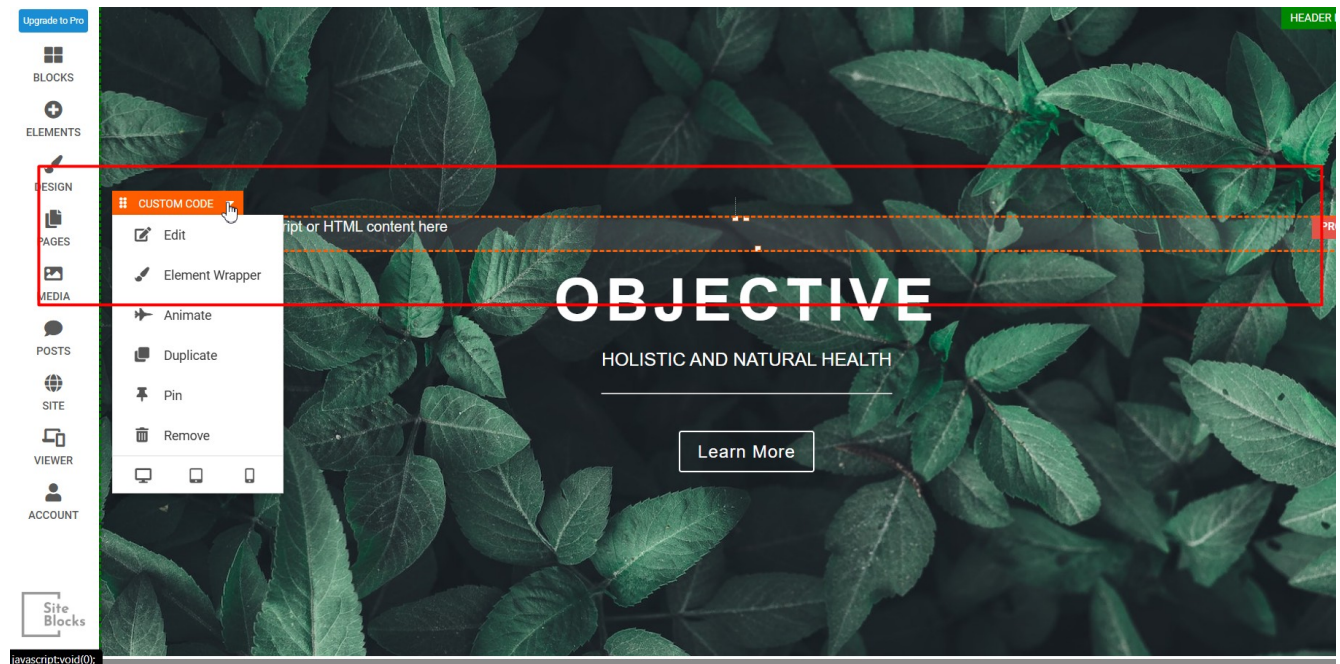
Step 2 : Click on the “Element” option then drag the “Custom Code” option to add Sitepal embed code.



Step 3 : Copy your Sitepal embed code and paste it on Custom Code option in website editor.



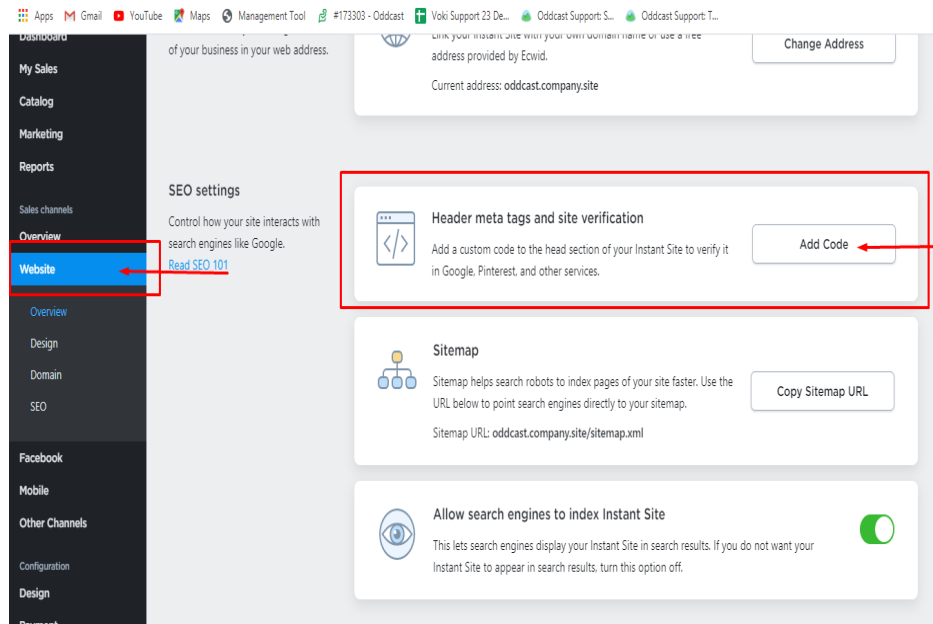
Step 4 : Click on “Edit” option and then paste the Sitepal embed code and then save it.



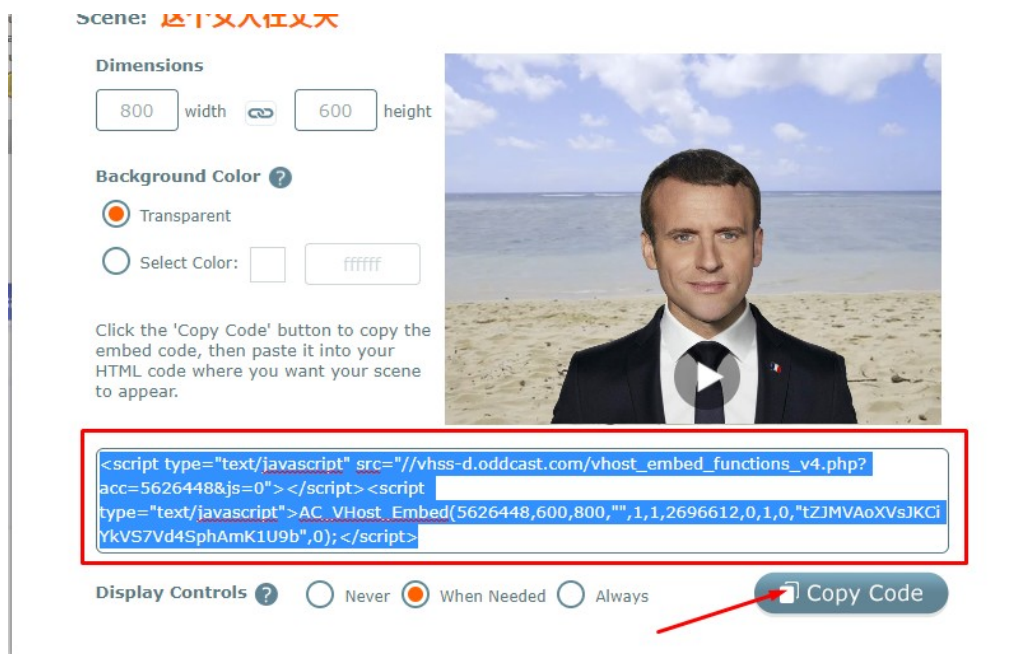
## B – ECWID

1) Step 1: Login to your ECWID account

2) Step 2: Go to Ecwid Admin >Website >Header meta tags and site verification.



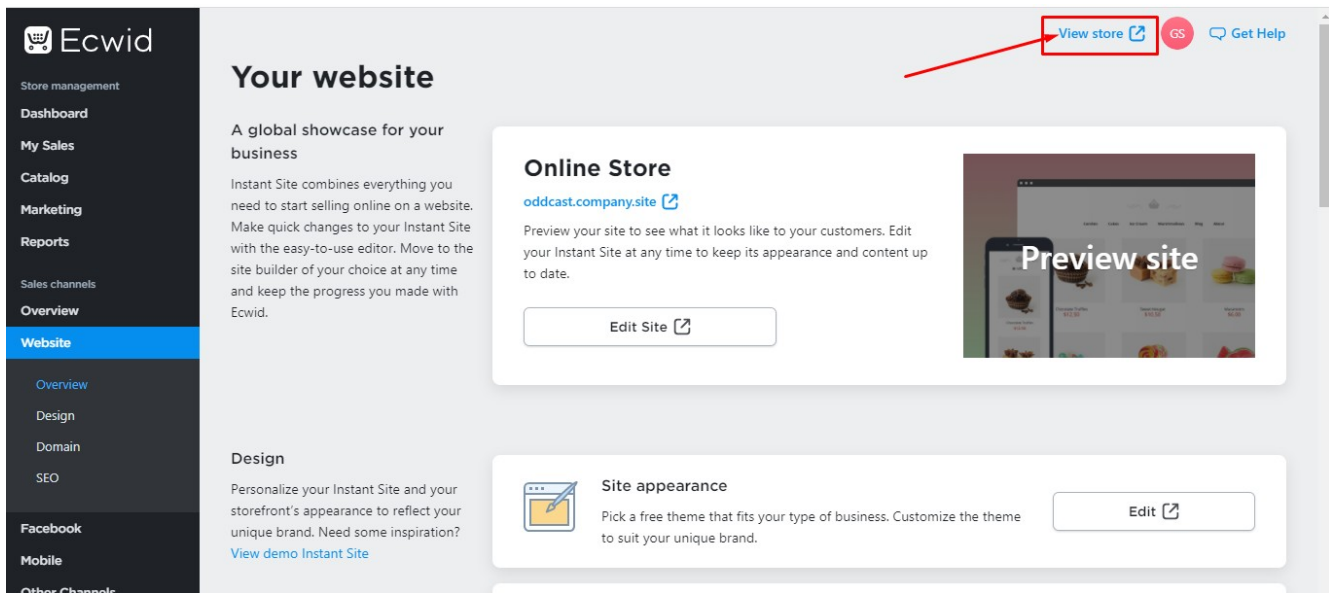
3) Step 3: Login to your Sitepal account and copy the Embed Code of the Scene you wish to embed.





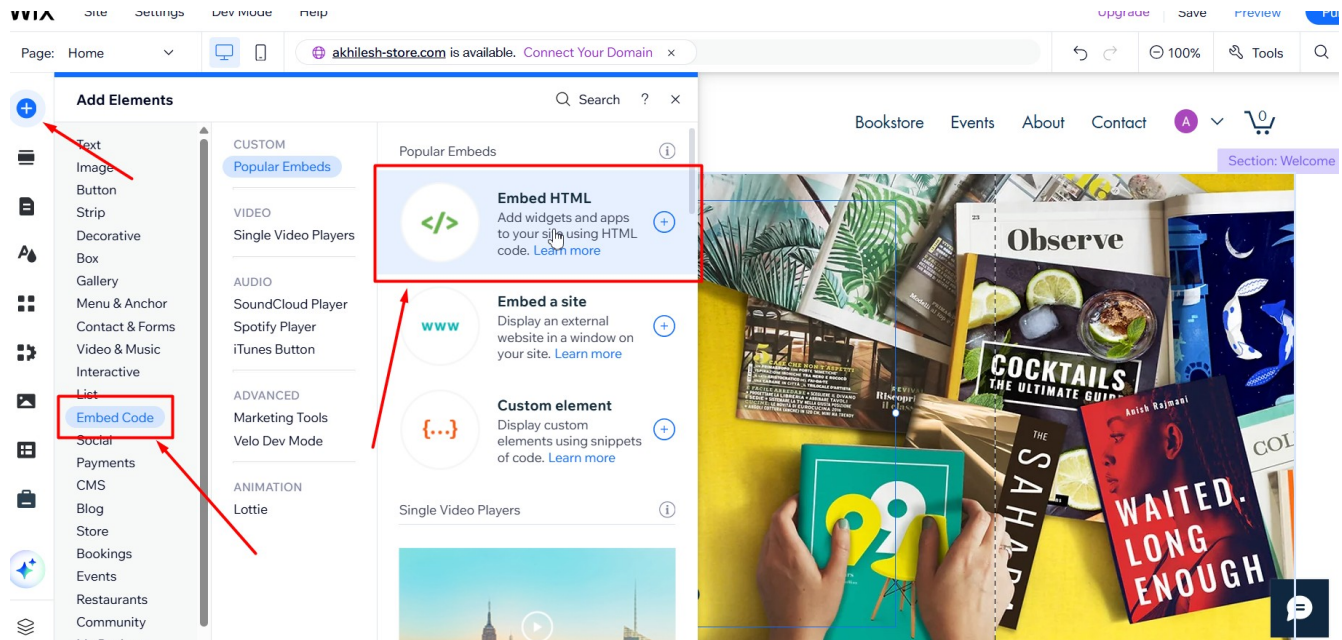
4) Step 4: Get back to your ECWID account, click ADD CODE and then paste your EMBED CODE (enclosed within <BODY> tags), click SAVE.

5) Step 5: Scroll up and click on VIEW STORE:

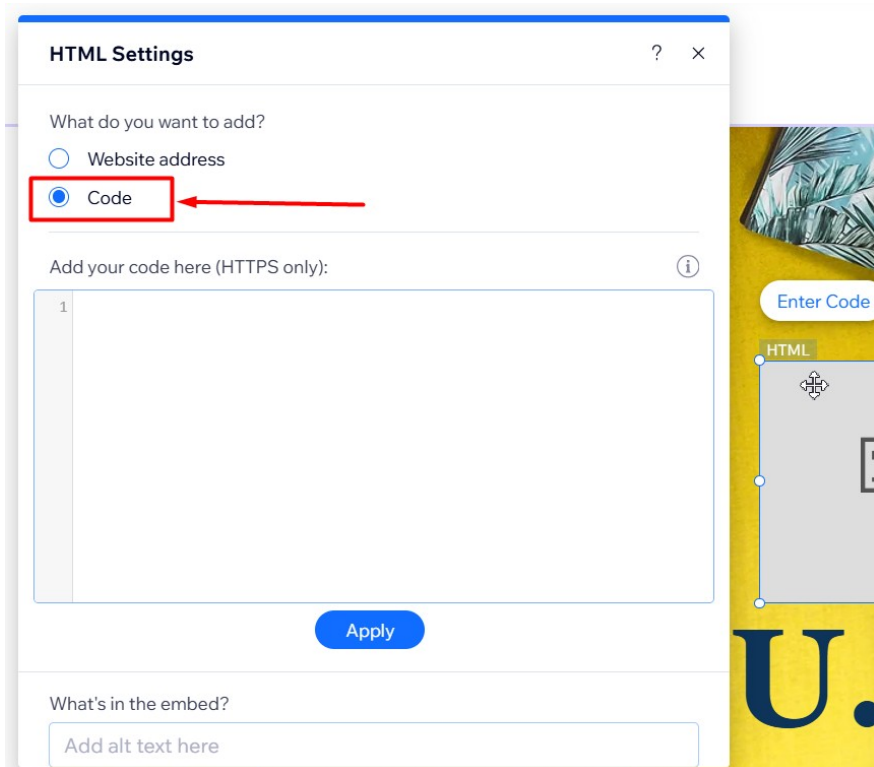


## C – Wix


Step 1: Click on Add button from left and then on “Embed Code” tab from More options. Click on “Embed HTML” option



Step 2: Click on “Code” option.



Step 3: Copy the embed code including HTML tags (within <BODY> Tags)

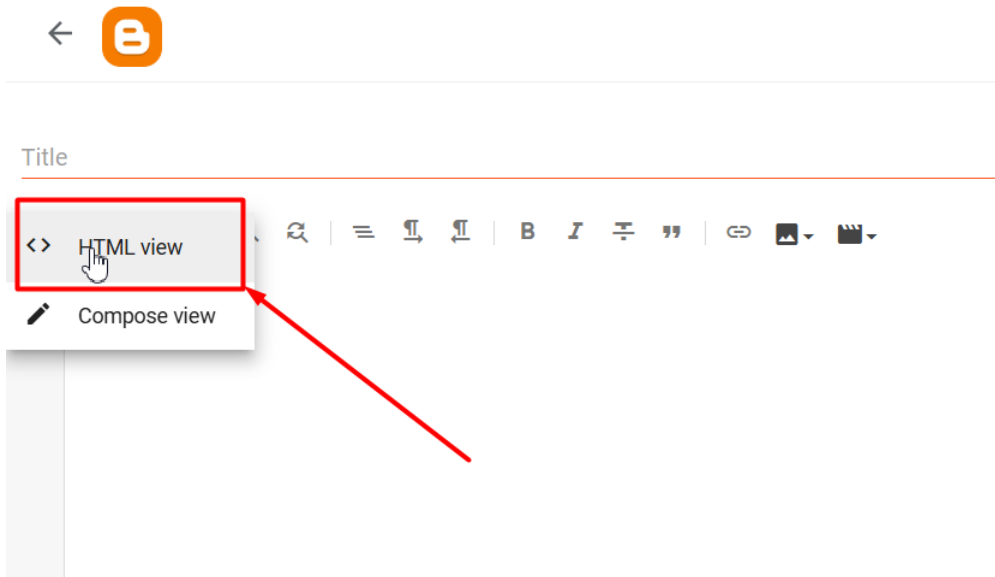

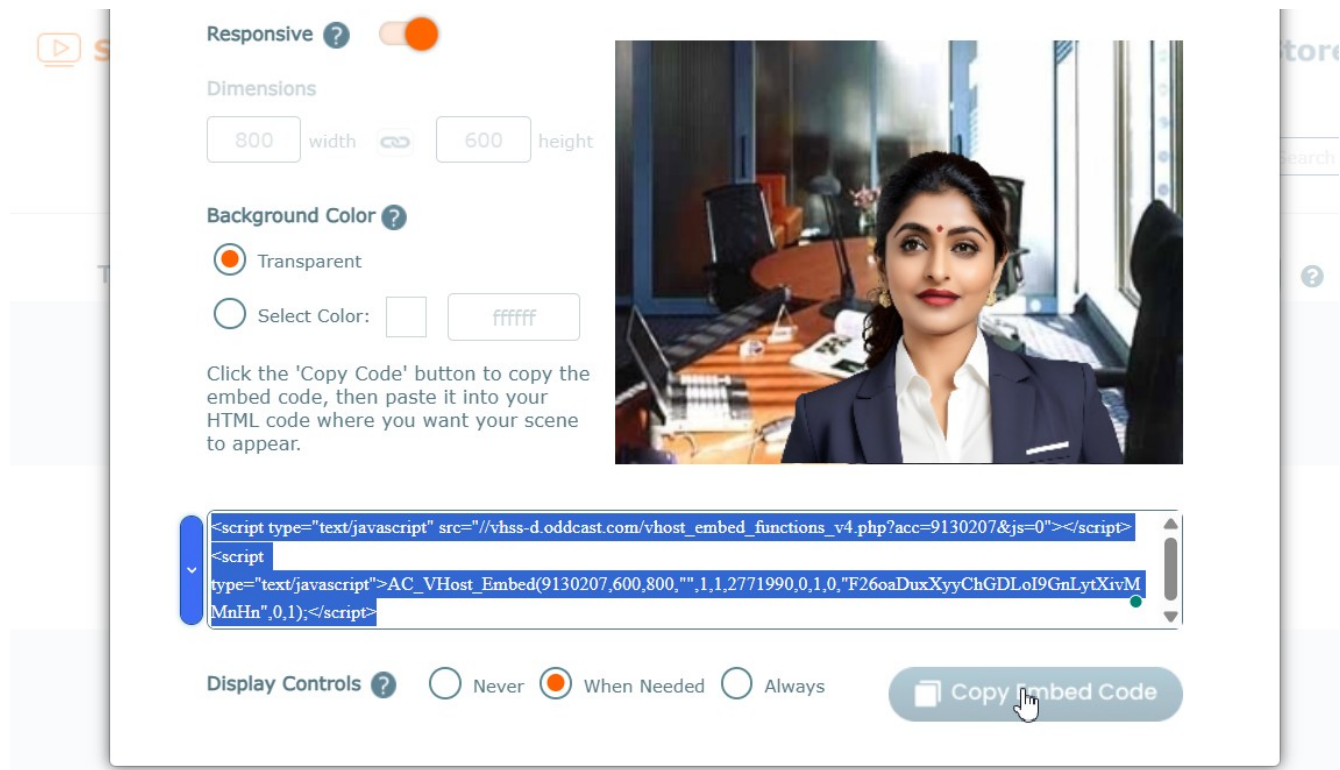


## D – Blogger

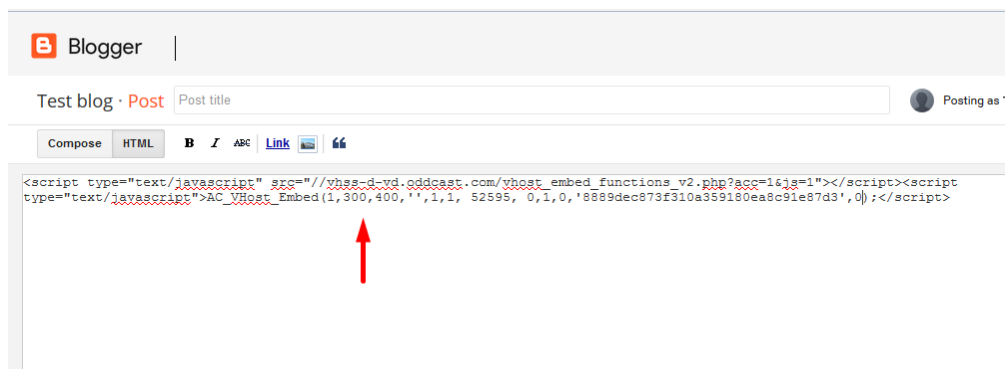
Step 1: Goto Blog post and click on HTML View button.



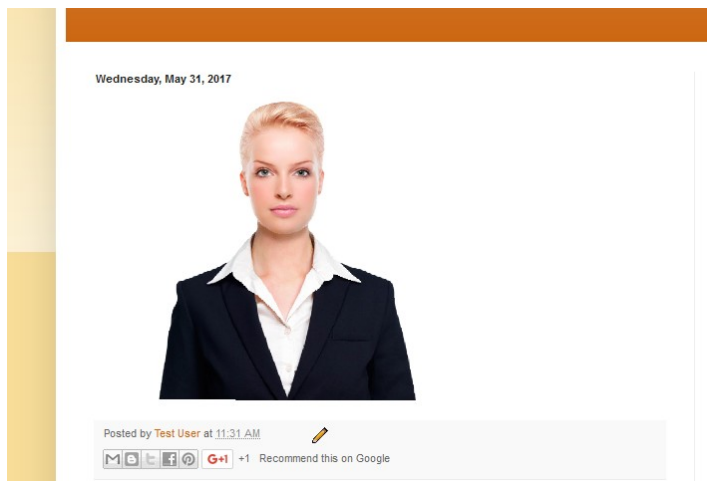
Step 2: Copy your Sitepal embed code.



Step 3: Paste the embed code in HTML editor.

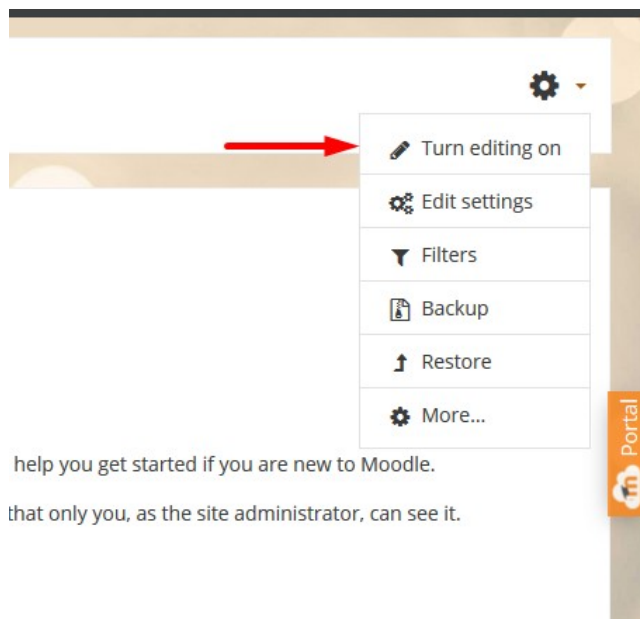


Step 4: Click on Save and Publish.

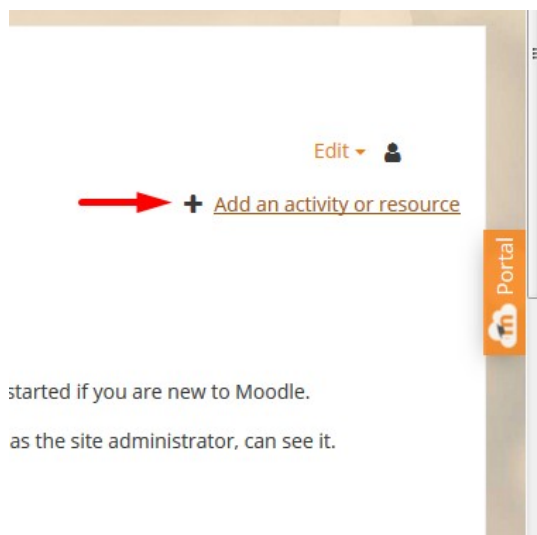


## E – Moodle

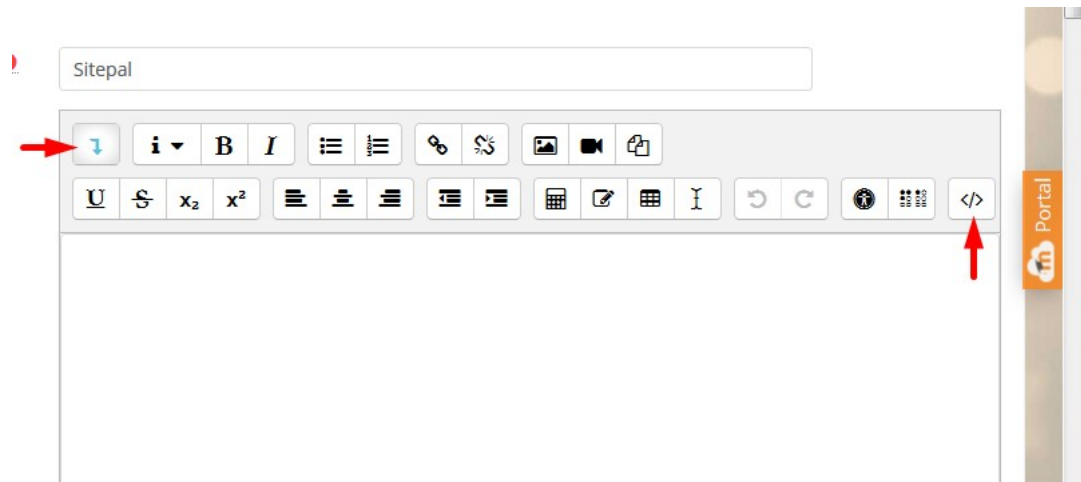
Step 1: Open Moodle site page and turn editing on.



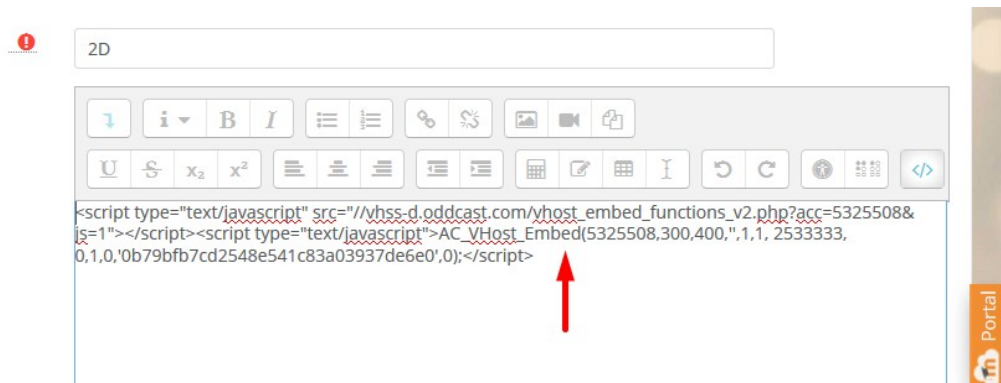
Step 2: Click on Add an activity or resource and select Assignment from activities.



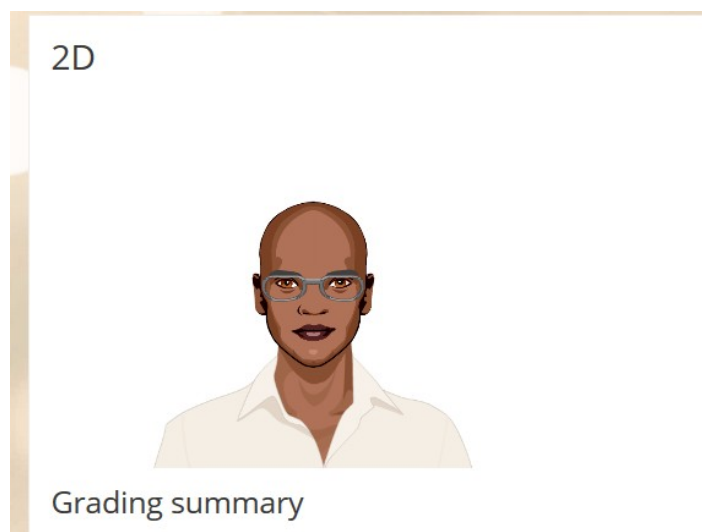
Step 3: Click on down arrow button then HTML button from description.



Step 4: Paste the sitepal embed code here and save.

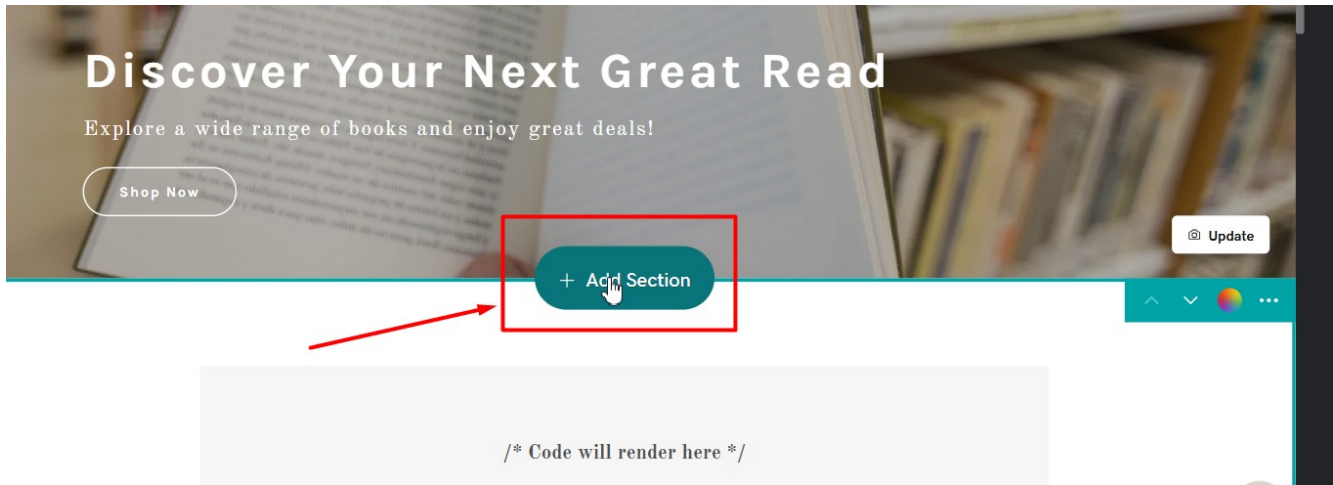


Step 5: Save the assignment.

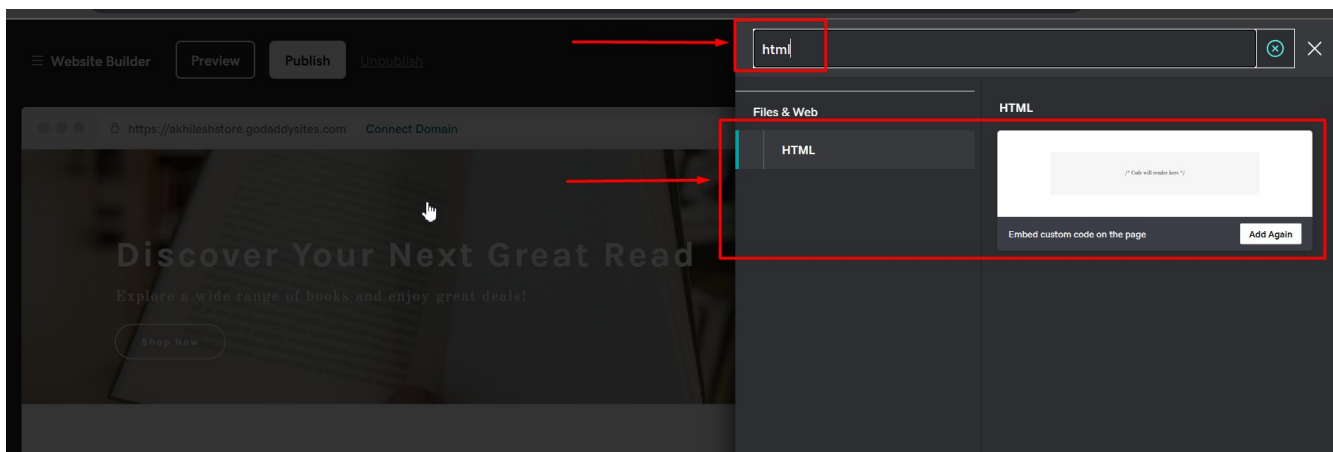


## F – GoDaddy

Step 1: Once logged in to your GoDaddy account you need to open your website and click on “Add Section” option

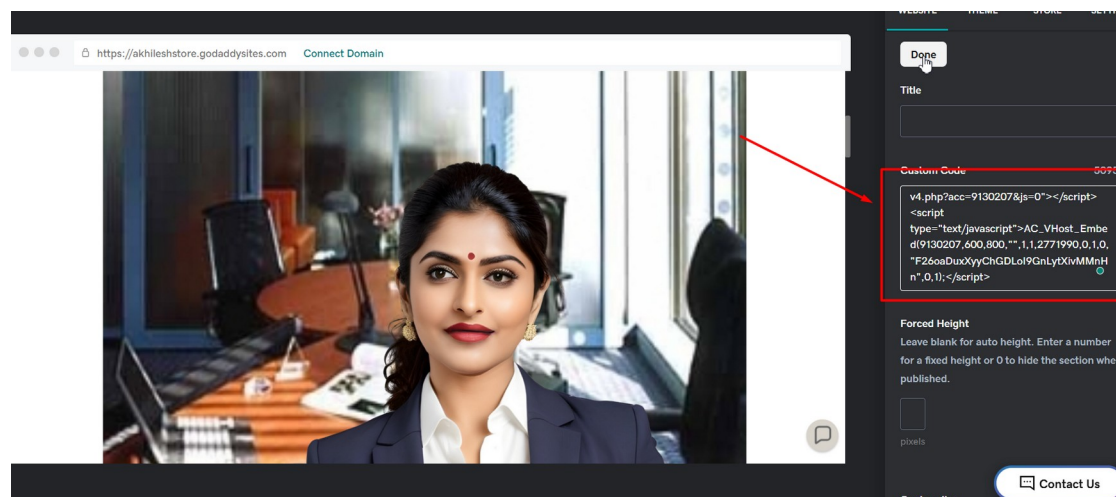
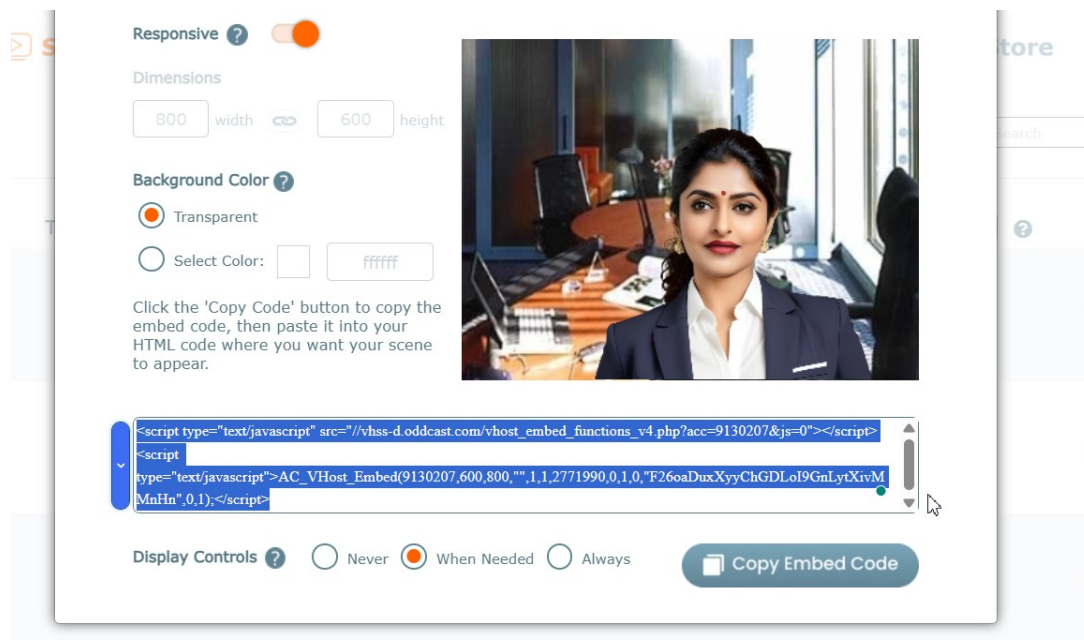


Step 2: Search for the “HTML” option then click on “Embed custom code on page” option.





Step 3: Copy your Sitepal Embed code and paste your embed code in HTML editor and click on done.

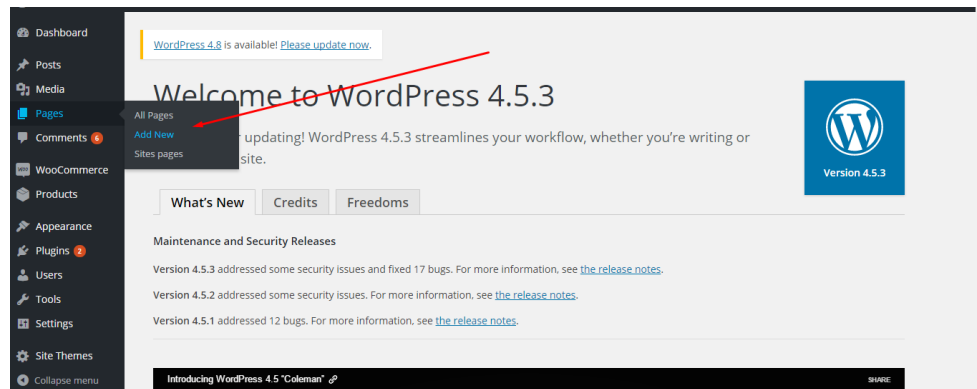


Step 4: Click on publish or preview.

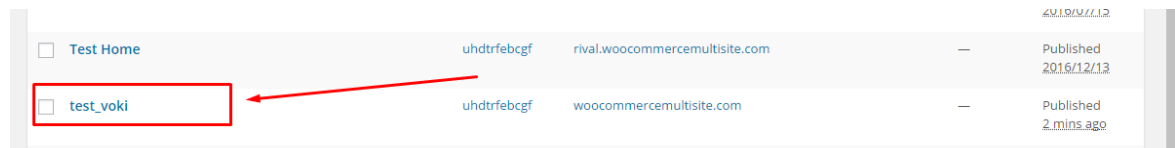


## G – Wordpress

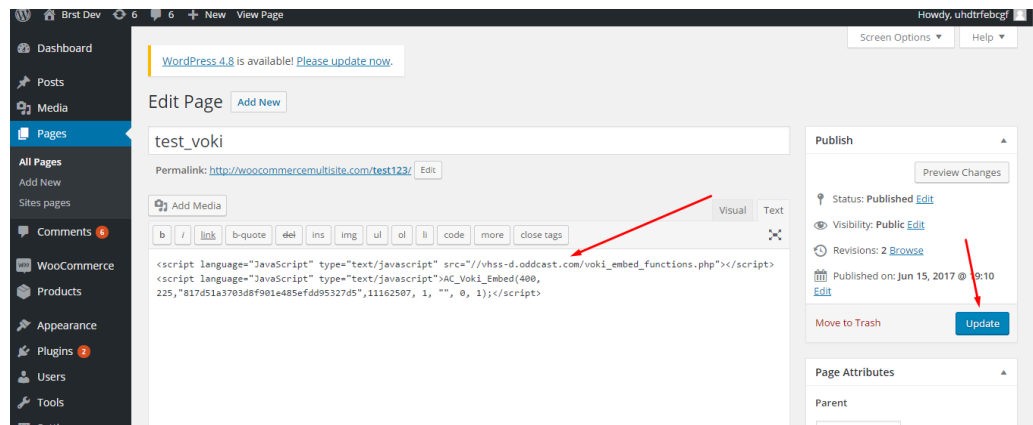
Step 1: Login to your WordPress admin panel and select All pages or Add new page from left option bar.



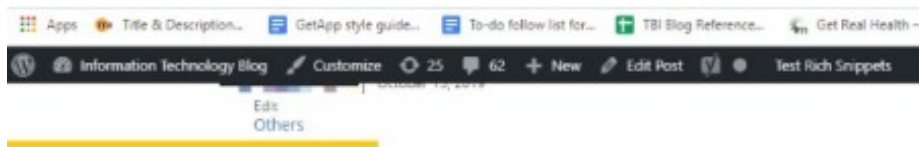
Step 2: Your created page will be shown in the list of pages and select where you want to add the scene.



Step 3: Select the text box and paste your embed code here and click update.

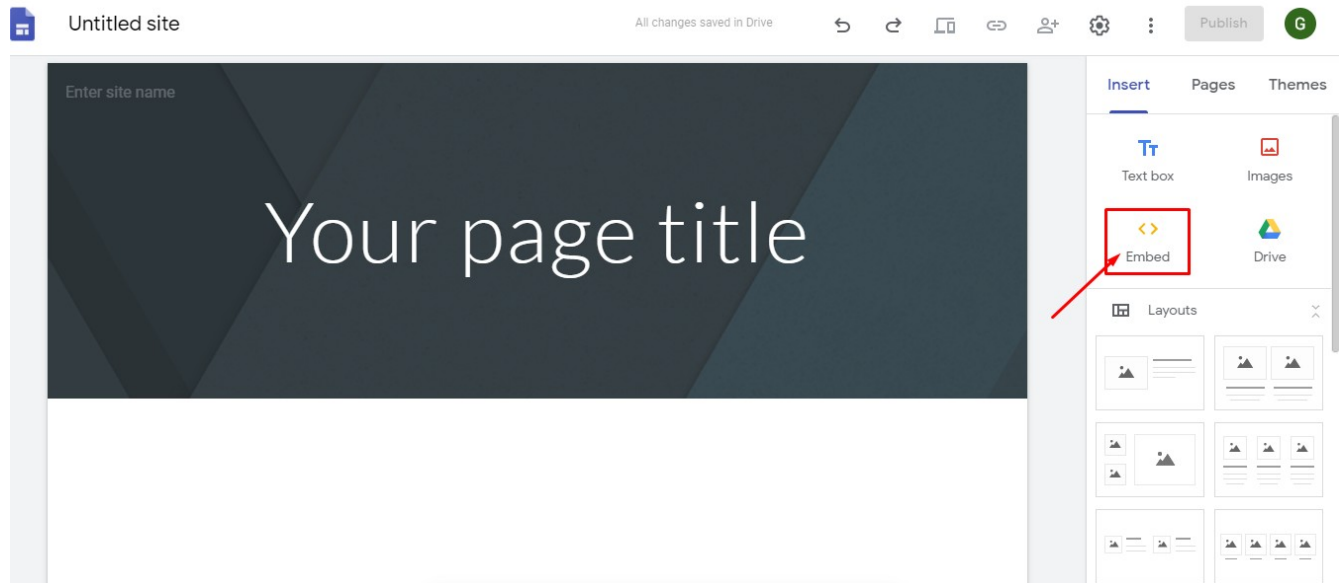


Step 4: Click preview changes to see the embedded scene on the page.

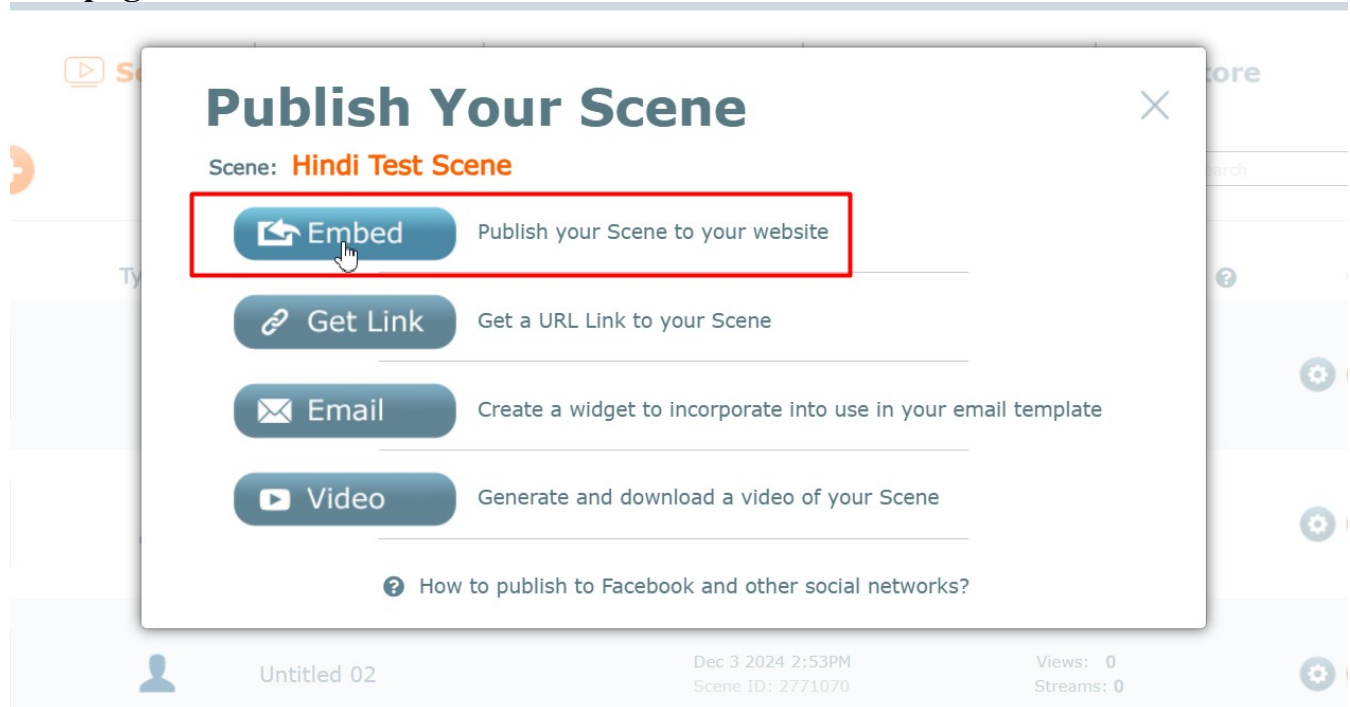


## H – Google Site

Step 1: Click on Insert >> Embed code



Step 2: Go to Sitepal Account, locate the **PUBLISH** button and then click on **Embed in web page**:

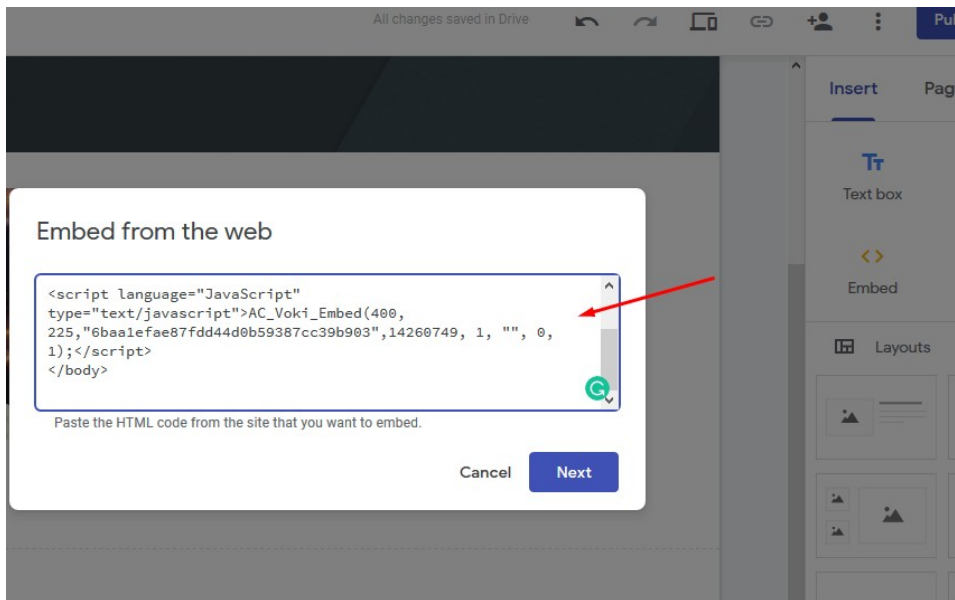
Click the 'Copy Code' button to copy the embed code, then paste it into your HTML code where you want your scene to appear.

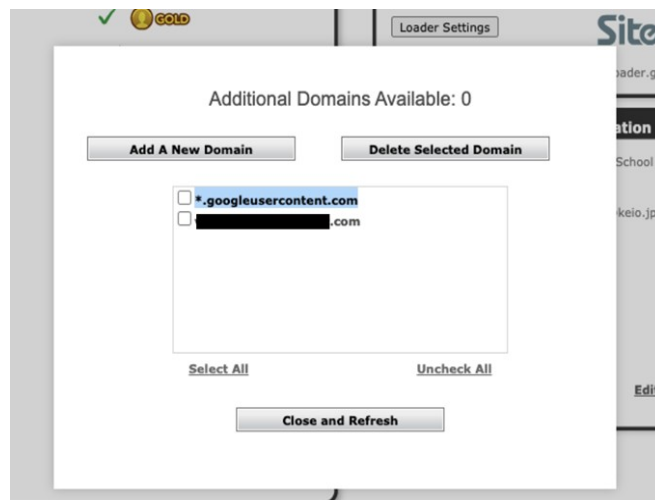
Step 4: Insert the embed code into HTML Editor within <body> tags-

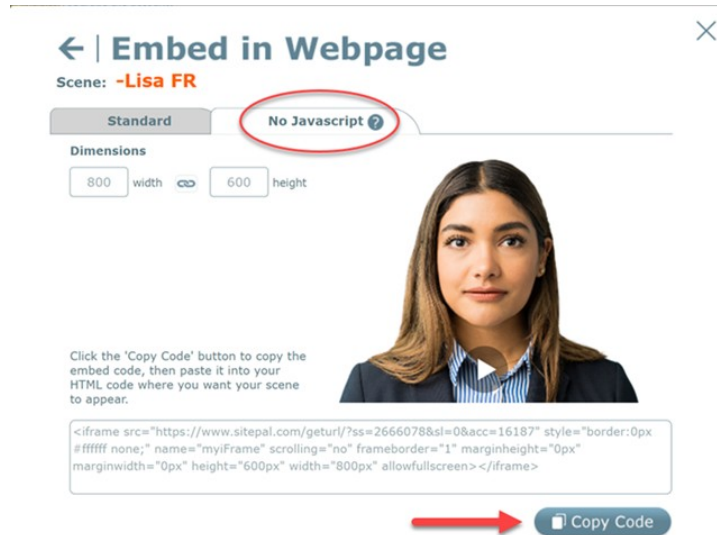

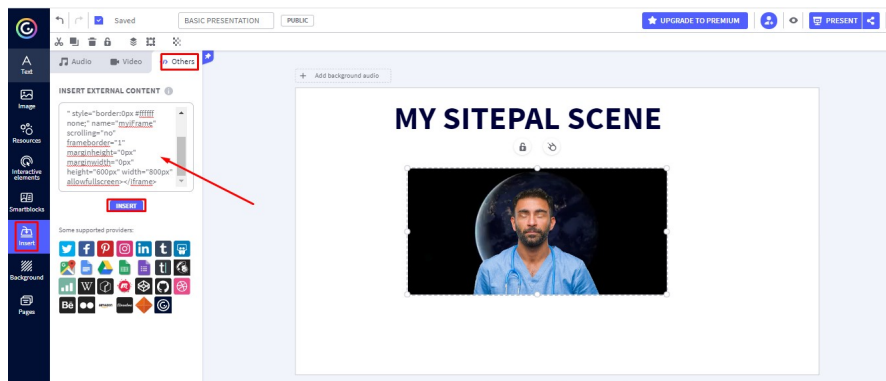

# I – Genially

**Step 1:** Login to your Sitepal account, get the “No JavaScript” embed code for the Scene you wish to embed.



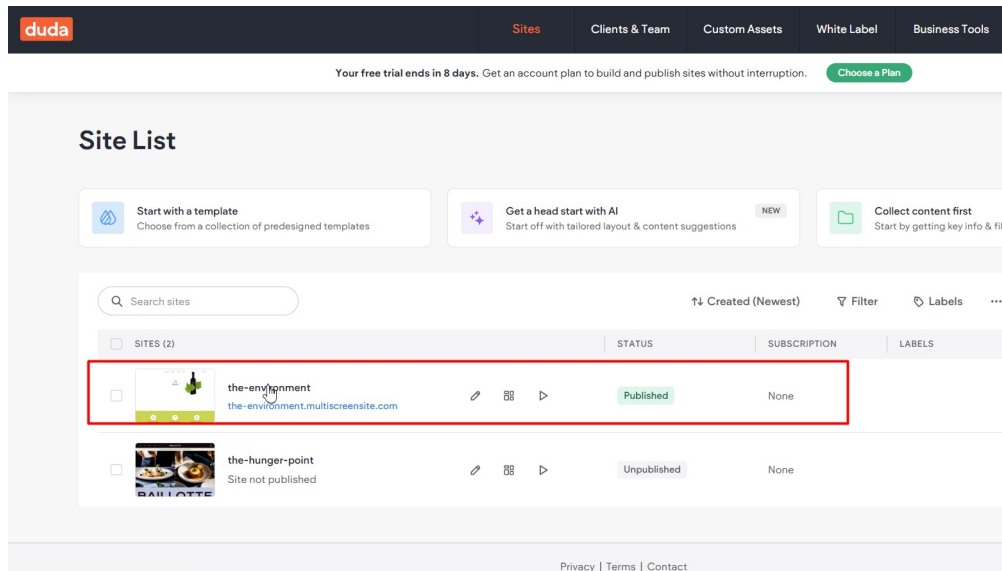
**Step 2:** Login to your Genially account. On the dashboard, click on ‘Insert’, then on ‘others’ and paste the embed code.



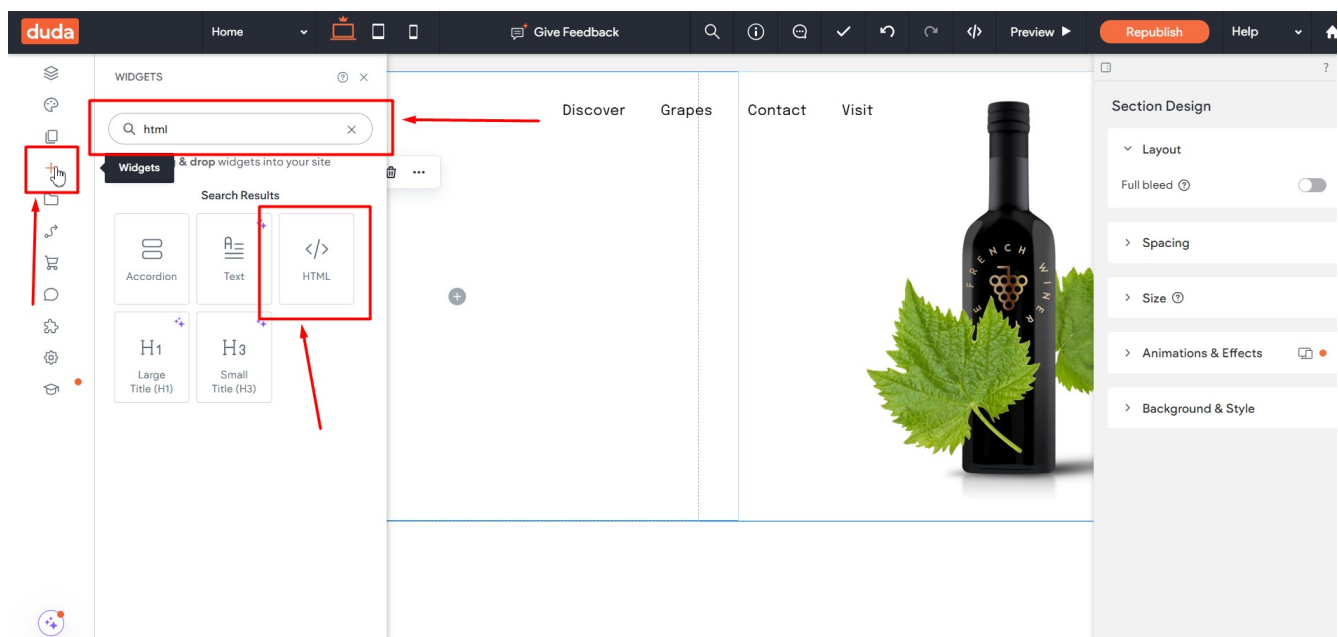
**Step 3:** Hit “All Set” to publish.

## J – Duda

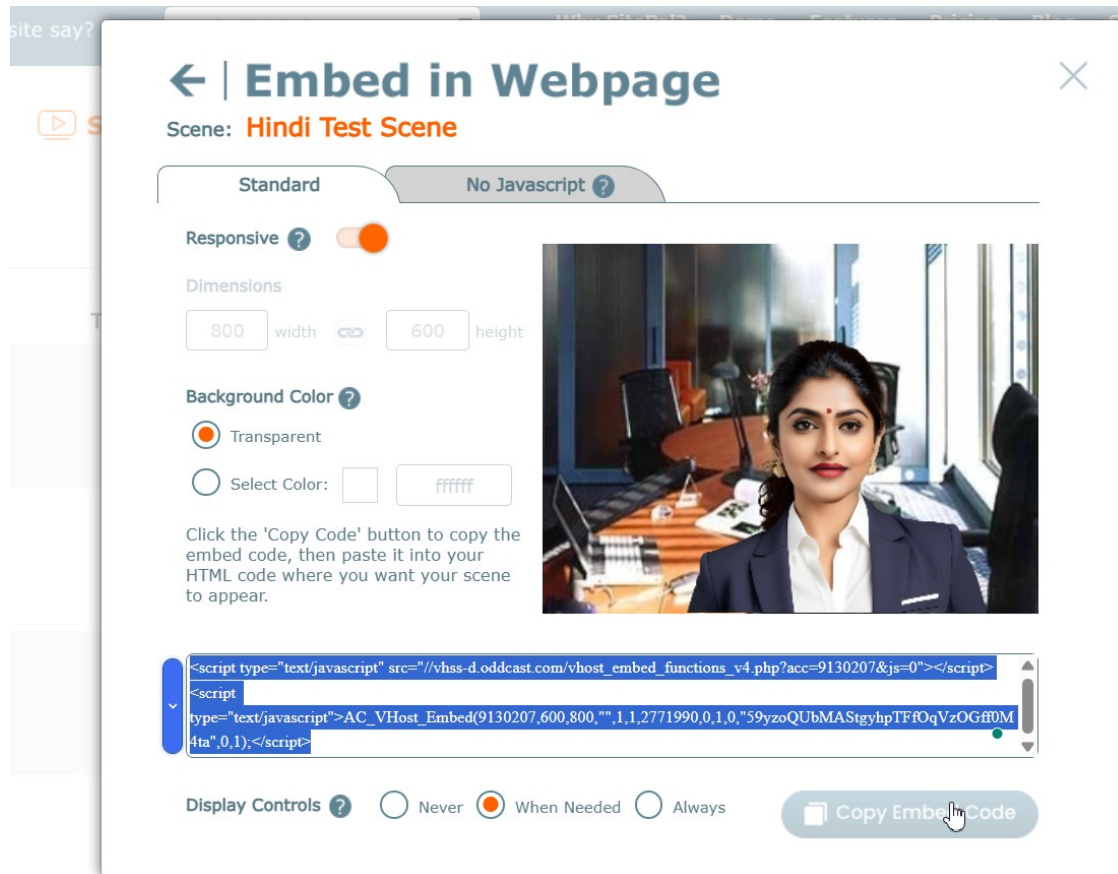
**Step 1:** Login to your Duda account and select the website you want to edit and click "Edit Site" to open the Duda website editor.



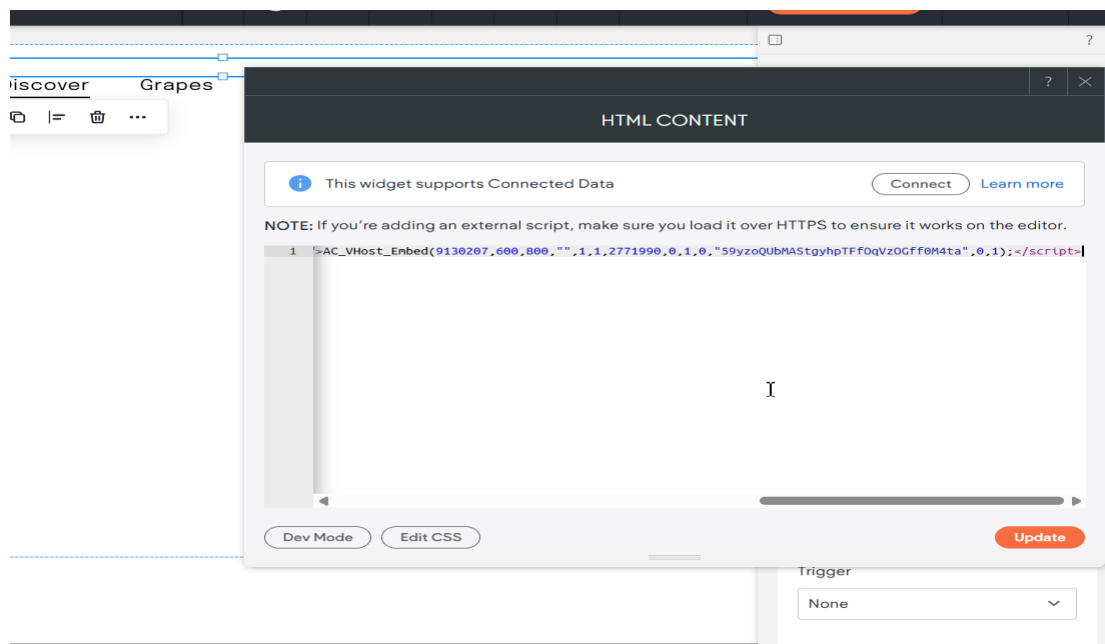
**Step 2:** Choose the page or section where you want to add your embed code. Click on the "Widgets" tab on the left sidebar. Scroll down or search for "HTML Code" widget. Drag and drop the "HTML Code" widget onto your page where you'd like to embed the code.



**Step 3:** Copy Sitepal embed code for the scene which you want to publish.



**Step 4:** Paste the code in HTML Content option and click “Update”.



**Step 5:** Click on Preview or Publish option to make changes live
