

Embedding SitePal in React JS

revision 4- 12/16/2019

You will need to make few changes to support React, as follows:

1) Please make a call to http://vhss.oddcast.com/vhss_players/sitepal/js/react_js_embed.js in your app's index.html file.

2) a. When loading your page, you need to make a call to `window.vhsshtml5_loadcharacter()` which is defined in "react_js_embed.js".

2) b. Also, add an api call to 'stopSpeech()'. This will ensure that if speech is in progress it will be halted. If speech is not in progress, the call has no effect.

3) When placing your embed code in your html page:

a. use the below syntax to add a wrapper element around your embed code (in red below).

b. replace the indicated parameter "0" value with "8" (also noted in red below)
